GOD, THE LORD OF LIFE

"As a bridegroom rejoices in his bride, so shall your God rejoice in you." Today's first reading from Isaiah shows us how much God delights in human life. He rejoices in us as in a bride. When you are experiencing the poverty of having "no more wine" of gladness in our life, what do you do? Do you turn to Christ?






