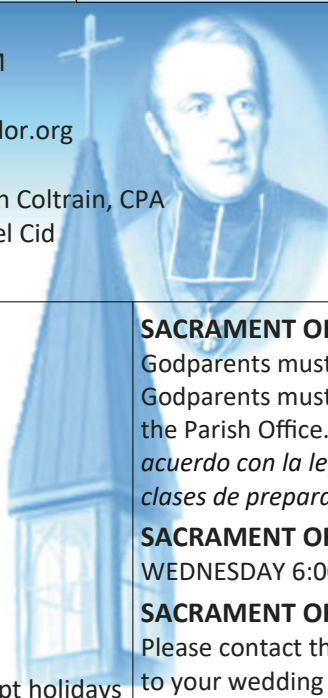

**WE AWAIT IN HOPE THE RETURN OF THE LORD**

On this 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, our readings remind us of an important truth of our Christian faith: the return of Christ in glory to gather his elect and make them share in his everlasting glory. This is our faith in spite of the occasional triumph of the wicked and their apparent going scot-free. Today's Word of God assures us that, on Judgment Day, perfect justice will be done: the virtuous will rise to be with Jesus in eternal happiness; the wicked will rise to bear the consequence of their rejection of God's call to conversion.

Such a message gives hope to all those who may not be getting their due in this life. It is also an appeal to those who are living in sin to go back to the Lord as soon as possible, for no one knows when the end will come.

If we pursue now this type of preparation for "the end," not only shall we not be afraid of it. We shall actually look forward to it, eager to welcome the Son of Man, to see him personally and not just under the sometimes-disappointing appearances of our neighbor. **That will be the day of the "mutual welcome": we will welcome him as our Savior, and he will welcome us into his Kingdom as his dearest brothers and sisters.**

Let the perseverance of the just and the conversion of sinners be among the main intentions for which we offer the Eucharist.

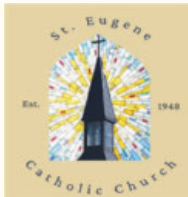

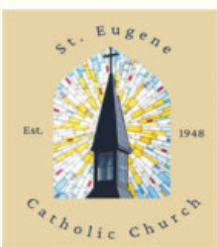

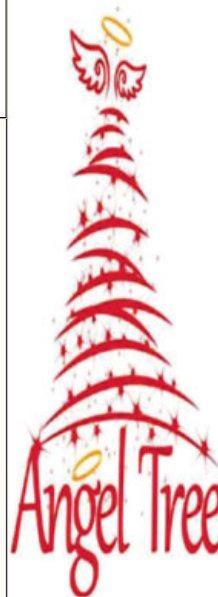
