<p style="text-align: center;">RETO DE CUARESMA</p> <p>Piensa en una manera en la que el Señor te ha sanado. Tal vez sanó una forma de egoísmo, una dolencia física o algo más. Esta semana, encuentra a una persona a quien puedas compartir ese testimonio y compártelo. No te preocupes si no aceptan que fue Dios quien lo hizo.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">LENTEN CHALLENGE</p> <p>Think of one way the Lord has healed you. Perhaps he healed a form of selfishness, a physical ailment, or something else. This week, find a person to whom you can share that testimony, and share it. Don't worry if they don't accept it was God who did it.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO</p> <p>Todos, quizá en algún momento de nuestra vida, hemos tenido la experiencia de jugar el papel de hijos-hijas buenos en la vida familiar. Pero, también hemos jugado el rol de no ser tan buenos como se esperaba. Entonces, esta parábola del hijo pródigo nos cae como anillo al dedo. ¿Qué sentimientos o recuerdos afluyen a tu mente al escucharla? ¿Sientes que el Padre es injusto con su hijo mayor? ¿Crees que ha consentido demasiado al menor de sus hijos? Cualquiera que sea nuestra respuesta, nos debe llevar a una reflexión profunda del amor incondicional de Dios para con sus dos hijos. Sin embargo, no perdamos el punto de vista de que Jesús cuenta esta parábola a publicanos y pecadores, y de cómo los fariseos y escribas criticaban a Jesús porque comía con ellos.</p> <p><i>“Con la parábola del hijo pródigo Jesús nos cuenta que Dios nos espera siempre, igual que el padre, que espera el regreso de su hijo. Él nos deja libres, deja que nos equivoquemos y aprendamos, y de esta manera volver, al igual que lo hizo el hijo pródigo” (Papa Francisco).</i> El Papa Francisco nos da la clave que debemos de llevar a cabo, aprender a volver cada vez que nos alejemos. No claudicar, seguir adelante y pedir perdón es de valientes. Aprender de los errores vividos y regresar para volver a un nuevo comienzo, pero bien acompañados de la gracia de Dios. Sentir fortaleza al escuchar: <i>“Tú estás siempre conmigo y todo lo mío es tuyo” (Lucas 15:31).</i> -©LPi</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">GOSPEL MEDITATION</p> <p>A man looking a bit downtrodden approached me as I filled my car's gas tank. He asked, “May I share with you my testimony about how good God is?” “OK,” I skeptically answered. He went on to tell me that he had been an alcoholic and drug addict, and that God had healed him; now he was four years sober. He said, “I didn't deserve it, but now I'm a different person. God is so good! Have a terrific Tuesday!” A few minutes later, as I drove away, I saw him smiling and handing a homeless person some money. I was confronted with a choice: either he was a total fraud or God had changed him. <i>Something</i> had happened to him, and it didn't seem fake. Maybe it was God.</p> <p>When Jesus heals the man born blind, the man becomes a challenge to everyone who meets him. They must decide. Is he the same blind person who they knew before? Who healed him and how? And what is the status of the one who can heal such infirmities? We shouldn't be surprised at the storm of doubt, hatred and animosity that swirls around the healed man — so it often goes when Jesus heals someone even to this day. Like we often do, the religious leaders confronting the healed man declare that God is not at work. They ask with mocking superiority and dismissive disdain, “You were born totally in sin, and are you trying to teach us?” (John 9:34). And they cast him out. When Jesus clearly works in our lives, in us or around us, we should accept it, and give praise and thanks for this wonderful manifestation of his goodness. -Father John Muir</p>

Los espejos no eran exactamente una moneda de diez centavos la docena en ese entonces. Pero me lo imagino de todos modos, ensayando las palabras mientras contempla su propia reflexión: "Padre, he pecado contra Dios y contra ti. Trátame como tratarías a uno de tus trabajadores contratados." En otras palabras, he hecho mal. No merezco nada de ti. Pero por favor, no dejes que me muera de hambre. Sálvame.</p> <p>La disculpa no era necesaria para conmover el corazón del padre. Lo sabemos porque antes de que se encuentren, antes de que se diga nada, el padre se siente abrumado por la compasión, no porque haya obtenido su satisfacción, ese tan esperado "Lo siento, me equivoqué." No, simplemente está muy contento de ver a su hijo con vida. Incluso sin disculpas, sabemos que el padre le rogará a su hijo que se quede.</p> <p>Entonces, ¿por qué el hijo se disculpa?</p> <p>El padre no necesita el "lo siento." No se está muriendo de hambre ni perdido. Siempre supo que era una mala idea. No necesita aprender ninguna lección. Pero qué tragedia habría sido si el hijo nunca hubiera dicho que lo sentía. Sin duda, su padre le habría dejado quedarse como trabajador asalariado, y habría tenido comida para comer. Habría sobrevivido. La disculpa lo devolvió a la vida.</p> <p>Dios no necesita nuestro arrepentimiento. <i>Nosotros necesitamos nuestro arrepentimiento.</i> -LPi</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman</p> <p>The Apology</p> <p>I like to imagine the Prodigal Son practicing his apology in the mirror.</p> <p>He wouldn't have, of course. Mirrors weren't exactly a dime a dozen back then. But I imagine him anyway, rehearsing the words as he contemplates his own gaunt reflection: "Father, I have sinned against God and against you. Treat me as you would treat one of your hired workers." In other words, I have done wrong. I deserve nothing from you. But please, don't let me starve. Save me.</p> <p>The apology wasn't necessary to move the heart of the father. We know that because before they meet, before anything is said, the father is overcome with compassion — not because he got his satisfaction, that long-awaited "I'm sorry, I was wrong." No, he's simply overjoyed to see his son alive. Even without apology, we know the father will beg his son to stay.</p> <p>So why does the son apologize?</p> <p>The father doesn't need the "I'm sorry." He isn't starving and lost. He knew all along it was a bad idea. He doesn't need to learn any lessons.</p> <p>But what a tragedy it would have been, if the son had never said he was sorry. Undoubtedly, his father would have let him stay as a hired worker, and he would have had food to eat. He would have survived. But he wouldn't have been what he was born to be. I often think of the son's apology as I am kneeling in the confessional, awkwardly reciting sins God already knows and is eager to forgive. <i>Why are you doing this?</i> some people would ask. <i>God doesn't need this.</i></p> <p>It's the apology, you see. The apology means everything. The Prodigal Son was dead. The apology brought him back to life. God doesn't need our repentance. <i>We need our repentance.</i> -LPi</p>

Lent

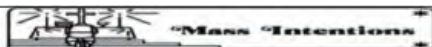
Question:

Lent always seems to help me renew my relationship with God and strengthen my religious practice. Do you have any suggestions as to what I could do to achieve that the rest of the year?

Answer:

The obvious answer may seem to be to do whatever you do during Lent all year round. But part of the power of Lent is that we focus as a community on renewing our faith and preparing for Easter. Our Lenten practices have a purpose and a goal. Therein lies the secret. When we focus our efforts on one virtue, or try to change one bad habit, or seek to deepen our understanding of one aspect of faith, we focus our efforts and give our full attention to what we are trying to accomplish. We tend to be more successful achieving our goals. More importantly, it has a ripple effect in our lives: one thing changes or is added to the spiritual mix of our lives and many aspects are changed.

All too often we leave our spiritual growth to chance and the practice of faith to habit, and then wonder why we have no sense of growth or progress. Think of it in terms of exercise. We walk, lift weights, bend and stretch to attain the maximum benefit from what we do. In addition, to keep those benefits, we eat healthful food and get enough vitamins and rest. Spirituality requires the same kind of attention: we pray, fast, read the Bible, receive sacraments, and do charitable work to maximize the benefits of practicing faith.
